Paralympic Boccia

Boccia can be played by individuals, pairs or teams of three and all events are mixed gender. The program is designed for any individuals who have Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy or a spinal cord injury resulting in quadriplegia or other physical challenges that limit range of motion in the arms and hands. The aim of the game is to throw leather balls-colored red and blue as close as they can to a white target ball, or jack. The jack is thrown first, and then each side takes turns to propel their ball towards the jack. The balls can be moved with hands, feet, or, if the competitor's disability is severe, with an assistive device such as a ramp. **The goal of the program is to learn a new leisure activity.**
